CIVIL AVIATION SAFETY AUTHORITY “PROVIDES ALL CLEAR”

GLADSTONE LNG PROJECT – FISHERMAN’S LANDING

The Board of Liquefied Natural Gas Limited (ASX: LNG, **Company**) advises that the Civil Aviation Safety Authority has formally concluded that the Company’s proposed Gladstone LNG Project will have no effect on the efficiency or safety of operations at the Gladstone Airport.

The Environmental Impact Statement, (**EIS**) for the Company’s Gladstone LNG Project, at Fisherman’s Landing, Port of Gladstone, Qld, was concluded on 14 April, 2009. The EIS included as a condition that the Company’s Gladstone LNG Project comply with any requirements of the Civil Aviation Safety Authority.

Mr Brand, the Company’s Managing Director, said that “the formal clearance from the Civil Aviation Safety Authority represents another important milestone for the Company’s Gladstone LNG Project and no further Commonwealth approvals are required for the first stage of the project”.

“The Company now expects its Gladstone LNG Project to obtain final development approvals for onshore components in the coming weeks”, Mr Brand further said.
