The **2017 Performance Rights** will partially or fully vest if the Company's total shareholder return (TSR) is greater than 100% of the TSR of the All Ordinaries Accumulation Index (with 25% vesting at 100% and full vesting achieved at 200% and the percentages calculated using linear interpolation for relative TSR between 100% and 200%) at the end of the measurement period, 30 June 2020. The percentage is capped at 50% in the event Company's TSR is negative.

The 2017 Retention Rights will vest 50% on the first anniversary of the grant date and 50% on the second anniversary of the grant date provided that participant remains employed on each respective vesting date.

In relation to the **2018 Performance and Retention Rights**, 5,190,000 Incentive Rights were issued on 10 July 2018, consisting of:

The percentage is capped at 50% in the event Company's TSR is negative.

The **2018 Retention Rights** were granted on July 1, 2018, and will vest 50% on the first anniversary of the grant date and 50% on the second anniversary of the grant date provided that participant remains employed on each respective vesting date.
